On behalf of the City of La Verne Active Transportation Committee, I would like to offer our support for the designation of proposed U. S. Bicycle Route 66 (USBR 66) through our community. We recognize that bicycle tourism is a growing industry and contributes to local economies that provide facilities for such tourists. As a community, we stand to benefit from this opportunity both economically and from the health and environmental related benefits of encouraging bicycle travel in our region.
